1. Emergency Contact Numbers

All numbers are Chinese. You should make sure you know how to dial a Chinese number from your phone.

2. Items You May Need on Arrival in China

You should make sure you have at least the following items for passport control in China. *Note: this is not an exhaustive list and you should check before departure if you need other documents.*

1. Your passport containing a valid Chinese visa.
2. Your invitation letter (this may not be needed with a tourist visa).
3. A completed arrival card (you will be given this on the plane).
4. Sufficient RMB to cover your initial travelling expenses.*
5. All hotel addresses and booking confirmations. If you booked the conference hotel, the address is included in Section 4 and the booking confirmation is included in Section 5.

* Note: ATMs in China will accept major international bank cards; however, we suggest that attendees check with their bank to ensure that their card can be used in China before departure.

3. Travelling to the Conference Venue

This section provides information on how to reach the conference venue from Shanghai's two international airports; PuDong and Hongqiao.

3.1 Conference Taxi from Shanghai PuDong Airport

If you have booked the conference taxi service from PuDong international airport, you will be greeted upon leaving the baggage claim area by a driver holding a sign bearing your name. The baggage claim exit is designed in such a way that it should not be possible to miss the driver. In the unlikely event that the driver is late, please wait near the baggage claim exit, where you will see other drivers picking up customers. You should pay for the taxi in cash during on-site registration. *You should not pay the driver directly.*

3.2 Bus from Shanghai International Airports

Bus services to Suzhou operate several times per day from both airports. The bus takes approximately 2.5 hours from Shanghai Pudong and 2 hours from Shanghai Hongqiao. Follow the signs for the long distance bus service at the airport. Tickets may be bought the same day in cash. Disembark at the first stop in Suzhou and catch a local cab to the conference venue using the address card provided in Section 4.

3.3 Rail from Shanghai International Airports

From Shanghai PuDong International Airport: follow the signs for the Mag-Lev station. Purchase a Mag-Lev ticket. Take the Mag-Lev train to Longyang Road. Follow the signs to the subway station. Purchase a subway ticket to Shanghai Railway Station. Take the No. 2 subway line to People's Square. Disembark and change to the No. 1 subway line to Shanghai Railway Station. Disembark and purchase a train ticket to Suzhou. Disembark at the first Suzhou station you reach and catch a local taxi to the conference venue using the address card provided in Section 4. The total time of this journey will vary due to the delay incurred buying tickets at Shanghai Railway station.

From Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport: Go to Terminal 2. Follow the signs for the subway station. Purchase a subway ticket to Shanghai Railway Station. Take the No. 2 subway line to the People's Square. Disembark and change to the No. 1 subway line to Shanghai Railway Station. Disembark and purchase a train ticket to Suzhou. Disembark at the first Suzhou station and catch a local taxi to the conference venue (using the address card provided in Section 4). The total time of this journey will vary due to the delay incurred buying tickets at Shanghai Railway station.

4. Suzhou Address Card

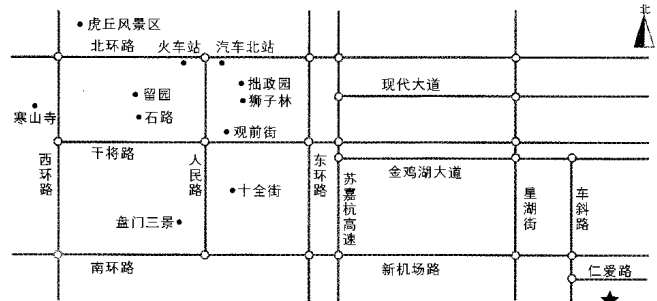
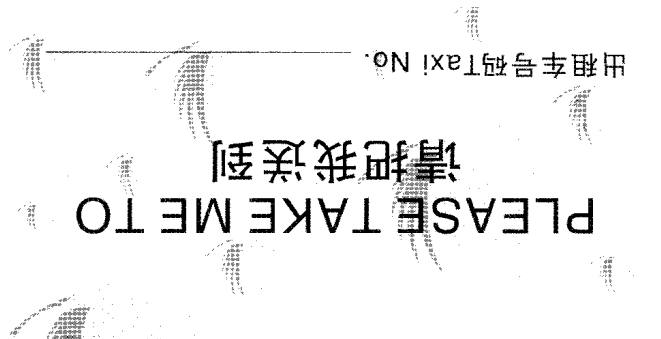

Major Chinese cities such as Suzhou and Shanghai should not pose any significant health risk to visitors, however, we suggest that all attendees should check with their local health authorities for recommended health precautions when travelling to China. In addition to official recommendations, the NESEA 2010 organizing committee recommends that attendees: (1) do not drink the tap water and (2) do not eat food from street vendors.
