

VISA INFORMATION

Foreign travellers to Australia do require a visa, however this is usually a very simple, quick and free process. For most conference attendees, the eVisitor electronic visa will be the most appropriate. An eVisitor is designed for people who are outside Australia and want to visit Australia for tourism or business purposes. Tourism includes holidays, recreation and seeing family and/or friends. Business purposes may include attending a conference, negotiation or exploratory business visit.

eVisitor applications are free, there is no application charge or service fee and you can stay in Australia for up to three months on each visit within a 12 month period from the date of grant. Apply for an eVisitor Visa here: <http://www.immi.gov.au/visitors/tourist/evisitor/>
